The Grand Design Wallcovering Collection

This is the expression of Italian excellence in synthesizing originality, style and technological innovation. The result of mastery of multiple artistic techniques - grisaille, tempera, stamps, pantograph, stencil and trompe oeil - and of advanced digital research, **Grand Design** is a unique solution for textile wallcoverings. The subjects of the collection offer an extension of more than forty meters and a height of three each, with digitally printed decorative themes on natural bases in linen, cotton, silk or precious blends, which give the subject characteristics of light, materiality, inimitable for quality and elegance.

The items in the collection, such as the **Sea Breeze** ** - on display until the end of the year at Salvioni Design Solutions, via Durini, 3 in Milan - are created in collaboration with the best students and artists of the important Italian Fine Arts Academies, applying the European artistic and textile industry to the contemporary technology of digital printing.

* "The Forest Network" fabric collection

Inspired by tree elements - foliage, roots, bark covered in moss and lichen — these fabrics take advantage of precious and clever textile contributions such as linen in DENDRON, or chenille in UMBRA. Structures are lighter in TETHYS with its linen transparencies, more robust and resistant in the wool construction of SEQUOIA, but they always offer an innovative visual impact, thanks to bright colors such as burnt sienna. Patterns that trace lattices throbbing with vitality and capture reflections and hues, light, and 3D geometries are set in cottons for PANTANAL, DEW, PHYLLOS e PINE LIGHT. Silk, on the other hand, illuminates FJORD - recalling rocks, currents and glaciers - or ignites ATHABASKA's precious lampas jacquard, reminiscent of ancient ritual forest bonfires.

KOHRO'S GRAND DESIGN collection is now one landscape richer. Inspired by the visual storytelling style of Art Deco and the mood of travel posters from the 40s and 50s, SEA BREEZE transports us to the California coastline: a dreamy landscape sprinkled between ocean and sky, sailboats and regattas, waters and sea breezes, punctuated by the broad flight of herons. SEA BREEZE is available on a satin base, measures 25 linear meters and comes in 5 color variants: Pearl, Sargassos, Dawn, Blue and Watercolour.
